

Coping with Illness

Insulin adjusting when using twice-daily insulin:

Mark has a cold. He uses twice-daily insulin and his blood glucose levels are erratic because he is ill. Look at what his diabetic care team have advised him to do:

- 1. Mark has noticed that his blood glucose levels are over 10 mmol/L all day. He should increase his breakfast and evening meal dose.
- 2. Mark then sees his blood glucose goes high only at lunch and evening meal. He should increase his breakfast dose.
- 3. When he feels better he notices he is having low blood glucose occasionally and needs to gradually adjust his insulin back to his previous levels.
